to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee, hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto Susan S. Watson

all that tract or lot of land in Greenville County, South Carolina,  
 in Cleveland Township, at Caesar's Head, lying between property now owned by  
 Susan S. Watson and the Beech Highway, being the following metes and  
 bounds:

Beginning at a point the cement heading of a drain pipe under  
 the said highway, on the west side of the said highway, and running thence  
 S. 27° 10' E. 66 feet to the corner of property of the said Susan S. Watson;  
 thence S. 62° 50' W. 248 1/2 feet to corner of the said Susan S. Watson; thence S.  
 55° 30' W. 55 feet to corner of said Susan S. Watson; thence approximately N. 62° 50'  
 E. 271.5 feet to the beginning corner, containing 1/4 acre more or less.
