Powell, of the State and County aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred Fifty (\$150.00) Dollars, paid to us by the Duke Power Company, a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of New Jersey, in the State aforesaid, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Duke power Company, its successors and assigns, the right, privilege and easement to back water in, over, upon, through or away from the hereinafter described tract of land to any extent deemed necessary or advisable by said Duke Power Company, its successors or assigns, in connection with the maintenance and operation of its hydroelectric plant known as "mumblin Snoals", as said plant is now or heretofore has been constructed and operated.

The tract of land upon which said rights and easements are hereby granted is described as follows:

"All that piece, parcel, lot or trac of land, lying, situate and being in Dunklin mownship, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and having the following me tes and bounds:

In the event Duke Power Company, its successors or assigns shall cease to use and maintain the dam and plant at mumbling Shoals, or any renewal of same as aforesaid, or to overflow or back water over and upon said lands, this deed of sasement is to cease and determine and said land is to revert to the said grantees, their heirs, and assigns, forever.

And we do hereby bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and foever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto said Duke Power Company, its successors and assigns, against us, our heirs and all others lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any
