Batson, Delinquent Tax Collector for the City of Greenville, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises and the sum of one Hundred Sixty Three and 43/100 Dollars, have granted, bargained, sold and released and do hereby grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Julius W. Davis his heirs and assigns.

All those certain two pieces or parcels and lots of land, situated, lying and being in Ward Five of the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, in South Carolina, being lots numbers eight (8) and ten (10) of a subdivision of land as represented by a plat made by J. N. Southern, Surveyor, June 21st, 1907, recorded in R. M. C.
