All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, near the city limits of Greenville, S. C., on the Anderson Road being a part of lot #3 on a plat of the Judson Mills property made by F. G. Rogers February, 1919 and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the Anderson Road 200 feet North of the intersection of Anderson Road and a 20 foot road (Judson Road) and running thence N. 55-5 W. along line of Fortney property 23 feet to a point in line of Richardson property thence southwest along line of Richardson property 50 feet.
