

stead as Trustee under both instruments, and all of the interested parties having requested and consented for the appointment and substitution of Henry J. Winn,
 Now, Therefore, It Is Ordered And Adjudged that
 thy said Henry J. Winn be, and he is hereby appointed
 and substituted as Trustee for Roger Moore Mills
 and Mary Moore Mills in the place and stead of
 Mary Ella Mills and Otis P. Mills, the petitioners
 herein, both under the Will and trust deed of Mrs.
 Susan C. Mills, and he is vested completely and
 absolutely with all the estate, interest, right, power,
 privilege and authority as were vested in the
 said Mary Ella Mills and Otis P. Mills under the
 terms and provisions of the will of Mrs. Susan C.
 Mills and also under the terms and provisions of
 said trust deed, and that he the said Henry J.
 Winn as Trustee shall be liable to all the ob-
 ligations, terms and restrictions as said Trustee as
 provided in said will and trust deed and that
 upon his giving the bond herein after required,
 and assuming his duties as said Trustee that
 the said Mary Ella Mills and Otis P. Mills shall
 thenceupon be completely exonerated and discharged
 from all trusts as declared in the Will and trust
 deed of the said Mrs. Susan C. Mills.

It Is Further Ordered And Adjudged that
 before the said Henry J. Winn shall undertake to
 act as Trustee for the respondents Roger Moore
 Mills and Mary Moore Mills as hereinabove pro-
 vided that he shall give bond to the Clerk of
 this Court with sufficient surety to be approved
 by him in the sum of five thousand (\$5,000.00)
 dollars conditioned to discharge his duties as
 such Trustee under the terms and provisions of
 the Will and said trust deed of Mrs. Susan C.
 Mills. The Court reserves the right to increase
 the bond of said Trustee to such an amount as
 it may hereafter see fit upon a proper petition
 being filed on behalf of the said Roger Moore
 Mills and Mary Moore Mills, so as to fully pro-
 tect their rights and interests, and for this
 purpose this proceeding is left open.
