All those two pieces, parcels or lots of land with the improvements thereon, situated lying and being on the eastern side of Reoover Avenue, near the City of Greenville, in Greenville Township, the County of Greenville, in the State of South Carolina; being lot #41 and the northern portion of Lot #40 as shown on plat of property known as "Cherokee Park" made by Brodie & Bedell, Engineers July, 1913 recorded in Plat Book "C" at page 96, being bounded on the north by Lot #4, now or formerly owned by L. O. Patterson, as Trustee, on the east by a 15 foot alley; on the south by lot now or formerly owned by Christine W. Camp; and on the west by Reoover Avenue; and having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at the intersection of Reoover Avenue and Gateechee Road at corner of Lot #4, and running thence along line of said Lot S. 62-32 E. 157.25 feet to a stake on said 15 foot alley; thence with the western side of said alley, S. 27-58 W. 75 feet to corner of lot now or formerly owned by Christine W. Camp; thence with the line of said lot, N. 62-32 W. 168 feet, more or less, to Reoover Avenue; thence with the eastern side of Reoover Avenue, N. 28-09 E. 66 feet 7 inches to a curve in said Avenue; thence continuing with the eastern side of said Reoover Avenue N. 74-30 E. 15 feet to the beginning corner; said premises being that conveyed to Mattie Walker by H. D. Grant by deed date August 8, 1928 and recorded in the R. M. S. Office for Greenville County in Book of Deeds "136" at page 132.

This conveyance is made subject to the lien of a mortgage given by Mattie Walker to Home Owners' Loan Corporation on December 3, 1934 in the amount of \$ 3200.00, securing obligations of even date therewith recorded December 21, 1934 in Book of Mortgages "248" at page 173 which said mortgage shall not merge with this conveyance but shall remain an open lien and charge upon said premises, so long as Home Owners' Loan Corporation may desire, with the understanding that said Mattie Walker is hereby forever released from the indebtedness thereby represented.
