*J. M. Johnson and Mrs. Irene Johnson, their heirs and assigns forever:
"All that piece, parcel or tract of land in Abuda Township, Greenville
County, South Carolina, containing 2 3/4 acres, more or less, having the following
metes and bounds,*

*"Beginning at an iron pin corner of property now owned by J. M.
Johnson and running thence N. 89 1/2 W. 14.63 chains to a stone on a branch; thence S. 82 1/4 W.
14.15 chains to a stone on a branch; thence S. 9 E. 3.10 chains to a sweet
gum X 3 mm; thence S. 88 E. 10.40 chains to red oak tree on Buncombe Road; thence
