" All that certain piece, bounded of lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Greenville Township, near the Paris Mountain Road on Bates street, and being known and designated as a part of Lots 1 and 2, on plat of the property of G. Denby Other, made by A. E. Dalton, April 1, 1912, and having according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:
