in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00)

to us paid by Annie Gossett,

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Anna Gossett, her heirs and assigns forever

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

All that tract of land on the North East side of the double tract of the Sou. R. R. containing one acre more or less, adjoining lands of B. Freeman, Mrs. Albert Watson, J. E. Means and Sou. R. R.

Beginning at the moun. of Culvert J. E. Means line and runs N. E. with the Branch to Mrs. Watson's Line a stake in the line and Branch; thence S. E. to the Sou. R. R. right of way; a stake in the ditch bank thence West with right of way to the beginning.
