all that piece, parcel or lot of land in _____ Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina

All that certain lot of land, situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, Town of Greer, which Springs Township, and on the south side of Emma Street, on which there is a church, and contains one acre, more or less. Beginning at the corner of Miller and Emma Street, and running thence with Emma Street Two Hundred and Ten (210) feet to the corner of J. C. Robinson's line, formerly Geo. M. Miller line, thence ^{with} said J. C. Robinson's line Two Hundred and Ten (210) feet to Mrs. Frances E. Wheeler's line, thence with said Mrs. Frances E. Wheeler's line Two Hundred and Ten (210) feet to Miller Street, thence with Miller Street Two Hundred and Ten (210) feet to the beginning corner, being the same lot of land deeded to J. C. Cunningham, J. D. Sanford, and W. S. James, as Trustees for First Baptist Church, Greer, S. C., by W. D.
