(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said John Thomas and Mattie B. Thomas, their heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land aforesaid, lying and being in Spick Springs Township, County of Greenville, and in the State of South Carolina, on the south west side of the road leading from Storline store on the Spick Springs road to the Unitarian Church on the Paris Mountain road, and containing 7.67 acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin in the center of said road, which pin is 200 feet from the corner of the Jim Davis property, and running thence S. 70° 42' 8.12 chains to an iron pin; thence S. 80° 08' 8.99 chains to an iron pin, corner of the lot now or formerly belonging to G. A. Turner, thence with his line, S. 70° 42' 8.12 64 chains to another pin in the center of said road; thence with the center of said road, N. 26° W. 7.70 chains, more or less, to the beginning corner, and being the same property conveyed to me in three separate tracts as follows:
