All my undivided right, title and interest, the same being an undivided one-fourth interest I now have to the following described parcels of land:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the Town of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina and having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at an iron spike on the south side of Emma Street, E. J. Hawkins corner and runne thence south with E. J. Hawkins line 203 feet to an iron spike E. J. Hawkins corner; thence East 83 feet to another iron spike; thence north 203 feet to an iron spike on the south side of Emma Street, 83 feet to the beginning corner containing 16849 square feet more or less. Being the same lot conveyed to my father, W. C. Duncan by deed dated April 13, 1916, recorded in the R. M. S. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 19 at page 210.

Also: All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate in the Town of Greenville, County of Greenville, State aforesaid, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron spike back corner of Mrs. Tanners lot and runne thence S. 17 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 157 feet to Hubert St.; thence with said St. N. 42 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 100 feet to W.C. Duncan's corner; thence N. 21 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 124 feet to Duncan's corner; thence S. 59 E. 83 feet to the beginning corner, containing 2 $\frac{1}{100}$  acre more or less. Being the same lot of land conveyed to W.C. Duncan by S. A. Westmoreland by deed dated May 4, 1912 and recorded in the R. M. S. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book Vol. 19 at page 380.

Also: All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate in the County of Greenville, Slick Springs Township, State aforesaid, on the south side of Emma St. in the Town of Greenville, having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at an iron spike on the back side of Emma St. and running thence nearly west to a new unnumbered street 100 ft.; thence nearly south 203 feet with said new street to an iron spike; thence nearly east line parallel with Emma St. 100 feet to an iron spike; thence nearly north 203 feet to the beginning corner. Being the same lot of land conveyed to W.C. Duncan by S. A. Stokes by deed dated Dec. 14, 1910 and recorded in the R. M. S. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book Vol. 9 at page 336.

Also: all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate in Greenville County, State, aforesaid, on the west side of Slick Springs Road and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning on a stake in said road and running thence S. 28 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 510 chs. to S. 2nd; thence S. 59 E. 196 chs. to a stake on W. A. Westmoreland's line; thence S. 23 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 510 chs. to center of Slick Springs Road; thence N. 59 W. 196 chs. to the beginning corner, and containing 1 acre, more or less.
