Emma Battie, her heirs and assigns,  
 "all that piece, parcel or lot of land, situated being  
 and lying on State Street in the City of Greenville,  
 known and designated as No. 181 on said Street  
 and as Lot No. 15 on the City Block Book and  
 having the following dimensions, to-wit:  
 Beginning at the Northeast corner of said lot  
 nearast Perry Ave. and running thence with State  
 Street a distance of 50 feet with a depth of approx-  
 imately 209 feet. Said lot adjoins lot now, or  
 formerly owned by J. E. Payne and W. C. Pyle and  
 others being 50 feet of the same lot of land containing  
 57 1/2 feet frontage, conveyed to Mary M. Calhoun by  
 Thomas C. Lyles' deed dated February 12, 1906 and  
 recorded in Vol. R.C.R.R. page 685 R. M. C. Office for  
 Greenville County, and being 50 feet of the same lot of  
 land conveyed by Mary M. Calhoun to the grantor  
 herein by deed dated June 16, 1933, and recorded in  
 the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 44,  
 page 296.
