Florence R. Barfield, her heirs and assigns forever:
All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Bates Township and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin in the White Horse Road and running thence S. 25 N. 14.30 to a stone, thence S. 52 E. 7.64 to a poplar stump, cm; thence S. 43 E. 2.20 to a stone; thence N. 74 3/4 E. 11.20 to a stone on a road, thence N. 5 E. 6.71 to a bend in road, thence N. 72 N. 6.75 to a bend in road, thence N. 9 1/2 E. 5.20 to a stone, cm; thence S. 75 N. 4.00 to a bend in the White Horse road; thence N. 87 N. 3.50 to a bend; thence S. 72 N. 5.65 to the beginning corner, and containing 28 3/4 acres more or less and being the same property conveyed to me by W. P. Granger by deed dated October 25, 1926 and recorded in the P. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 108, page 356.
