All my undivided one-half right title, interest and
estate of, in and to that certain tract of land in
Cochrane Springs Township, said County and State,
situate on the southside of Enoree River and on
the Brushy Creek Road, known as a part of the
Edwards Place, and delineated as follows:
Beginning at an iron pin on the old Brushy Creek
Road, and runs thence
S 26 3/8 W 475 feet to a willow tree; thence
S 22 2 E 275 feet to a stake; thence
S 17 7/8 W 256 feet to a water-oak; thence
S 1 E 133 feet to a poplar; thence
S 66 1/4 E 564 feet to a black-gum tree; thence
N 51 E 364 feet to a stone; thence
N 27 W 316.8 feet to a stone; thence
N 11 W 94 feet to a stone; thence
N 18 1 E 266.6 feet to a pine; thence
N 62 2 E 1914 feet to a sweetgum tree; thence
N 8 1 E 115.5 feet to a stake; thence
N 74 E 140 feet to a branch; thence
N 37 E 178 feet to a poplar; thence
N 19 E 172 feet to a whiteoak on bank of Enoree
River; thence up said River with the meanders there-
of to bridge on said Brushy Creek Road; thence
westward 139 feet to an angle in road; thence
S 22 2 W 258 feet to angle in road; thence
S 86 2 W 295 feet to the beginning corner, and be-
ing Tract No. 3 of the Edwards property as shown by
plat made by N. S. Brockman, April 7th, 1919, and
containing thirty seven and seventy-seven one-hun-
dredths (37.77) acres, more or less;

Also tract adjoining the one above described, and be-
