to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto W. D. Cely,

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situated lying and being in Cleveland Township, County and State aforesaid and having the following lines and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at a stake on the north side of Oil Camp Drive at the Northwest corner of lot now owned by W. D. Cely, the grantee herein, known as Lot #77-B, on revised plat, Section A of property of the grantor and running thence with line of other property of the said grantee N. 33-02 W. 210.4 feet to a stake; thence S. 55.00 W. 50 feet to a stake; thence S. 33-02 E. 210.4 feet, more or less, to a stake on the north side of Oil Camp Drive; thence with the north side of Oil Camp Drive; N. 55-45 E. 50 feet to the point of beginning.
