KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That The South Carolina National Bank of

to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee, hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto Elta Goritt,

All that certain lot of land on the south side of Buncombe Street, in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid: Beginning at a point 117 feet from the southeast corner of intersection of Butler Ave. and Buncombe Street, and running thence along the south side of Buncombe Street, S. 22° 55' E. 48 feet to iron pin; thence S. 55° 33' W. 56 feet to corner; thence S. 30° 36' W. 64 feet to corner; thence N. 64° 20' W. 41 feet to corner; thence N. 8° 20' E. 54 feet to corner; thence N. 55° 33' E. 97.2 feet to the beginning, on which is a two story stucco dwelling, and being part of the land conveyed to J. D. Gilreath by Mrs. Fannie S. Swinn by deed dated January 18, 1897, recorded in R. M. C. Office for said County and State in Book CCC, Page 591, and metes and bounds being more fully shown on plat of Dalton and Neves, December, 1928, and being the same tract of land conveyed to the South Carolina National Bank of Charleston by E. Inman, Master, by deed dated January 14, 1931, recorded in Vol. 149, Page 478 in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, reference to which is hereby saved.
