P. J. Irvin, C. H. Irvin, and Her Heirs and Assigns,
 all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville
 Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, near the
 corporate limits of the City of Greenville, being shown as Lot
 No. 6 in plat of property known as "Castor," made by P.
 C. Jackson, Esq., in July, 1920, recorded in the R. M. C.
 Office for Greenville County in Plat Book 1, at Page 42,
 and running the following courses and distances
 according to said plat:

Beginning at an iron pin on the Northeast side of Beech-
 wood Avenue, 240 feet North of Ackley Street, corner of Lat.
 40° 40' 46", and running thence with the line of said lot, N.
 64° 30' 15" E. 152.5 feet to an iron pin in line of Irvine Estate.
 Thence with Irvine's line, N. 26° 49' 21".60 feet to an iron pin,
 corner of lot No. 6; thence with the line of said lot, S.
 64° 30' 21".155.1 feet to an iron pin on Beechwood Avenue;
 thence with Beechwood Avenue, S. 22° 26' E. 60 feet to the
 beginning corner, said property being that conveyed
 to the grantor by St. R. Jackson, by deed dated May 24,
 1937, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville

 pertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the grantee, hereinabove named, and her
 heirs and assigns forever.

And the said granting corporation does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the
 grantee hereinabove named, and her
 heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
