I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, *Farm Lumber Loan Corporation*

on or about the *11th* day of *September* in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and *thirty seven* exhibited *its* complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against *J. D. Wood and Pleasant Grove Savings Bank*  
*vs. F. L. Corporation*

demanding judgment in relation to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the *15th* day of *October*, 19*37*, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a Decree

of the said Court, wh. rely it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described be sold by E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, on the terms and for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court will appear; and the Master, after having duly advertised the said real estate

for sale by public outcry on the *1st* day of *November* in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and *thirty seven* did then openly and publicly, according to the custom of auctions, sell and dispose of the same unto *Farm Lumber Loan Corporation*

for the sum of *two thousand five hundred fifty and no/100 (\$2,150.00)* Dollars, being at that price the highest bidder thereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of *two thousand five hundred fifty and no/100 (\$2,150.00)* Dollars, to me paid by the said *Farm Lumber Loan Corporation*

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said *Farm Lumber Loan Corporation*

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the improvements thereon, to be included thereon, situate, lying and being, on the eastern side of Pleasant Grove Church Road, near the town of Farm in Cooks Spring Township, in the County of Greenville, in the State of South Carolina, being bounded on the north by parsonage lot of the Pleasant Grove Church, on the east and south by property now or formerly owned by J. D. Wood, on the west by Pleasant Grove Church Road, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at a point in the center of said Pleasant Grove Church Road, where of the parsonage lot, and running thence with the line of said lot, S. 80 1/2 E. 297 feet to corner of J. D. Wood property; thence with the line of said property, S. 2 W. 247 feet to corner of said J. D.
