I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, *Mrs. C. H. Allevine, C. W. Allevine and Ansel Allevine, trading as Taylors Lumber Company*

on or about the *24th* day of *March*, in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and *thirty-eight*, exhibited *this* complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against *Lilyan Blanche Wilkison (sometimes known as Blanche L. Wilkison)*, et al.

demanding judgment in relation to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the *29th* day of *April*, *1938*, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in *a decree*

of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described be sold by E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, on the terms and for the purpose aforesaid in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court will appear; and the Master, after having duly advertised the said real estate,

for sale by public outcry on the *6th* day of *June*, in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and *thirty-eight*, did then openly and publicly, according to the custom of auctions, sell and dispose of the same unto *Mrs. Ollie S. Brumfield*.

NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of *Five thousand and 00/100 (\$5000.00)* Dollars, to me paid by the said *Mrs. Ollie S. Brumfield*,

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said *Mrs. Ollie S. Brumfield*, "All those certain pieces, parcels or lots of land near the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, and State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lots Nos. 23 and the Eastern half of Lot No. 22, situate on the South side of East Fair Road, as shown on a plat entitled "Survey of Block 23 and one-half of property of St. St. Butter Associates" recorded in the R. M. L. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book 4, at page 288 and having in the aggregate, according to said plat, and a more recent survey entitled "Property of Lilyan Blanche Wilkison", made by P. C. Dalton, Engineer, January 1938, the following metes and bounds to wit:
