"All that piece, parcel, lot or tract of land, lying, situated, and being in Ward Three, City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being described as follows: Beginning at a stake on the West side of South Main Street on Northeast corner of lot described in the mortgage of John T. Woodville to Mrs. Sarah R. Davidson (which stake is 25 feet North from the North side of a 12 ft. alley lying immediately North of the land now or formerly belonging to Markley Hardware and Mfg. Co) and running thence Northward along Main St., 25 feet to the Southeast corner of lot belonging to Mrs. Sarah R. Davidson; thence along Mrs. Sarah R.
