WHEREAS, *Belle B. Hunt, Executrix of the Estate of*  
*J. J. Hunt, Deceased*

on or about the 3d day of September, in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and thirty-eight, exhibited her complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against Treasurer Goldsmith Biengard, et al.

demanding judgment in relation to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 9th day of December, 1938, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree

NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One Thousand (\$1000.00) Dollars, to me paid by the said Bessie Goldsmith,

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said Bessie Goldsmith,

"All that certain piece, parcel, or tract of land situate, lying, and being in Austin Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and having, according to a plat made by W. J. Riddle, surveyor, January 21, 1938, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin in the center of Spartanburg Road at the corner of property of J. D. Haddell and running thence along the line of the Haddell property S. 66° E. 879 feet to a stake corner of property of Henry Goldsmith estate, thence along the line of property of Henry Goldsmith estate N. 14° 11' 15" feet to an iron pin on the east side of said Spartanburg highway; thence N. 10° 15' E. 263 feet to stake; thence N. 13 E. 1520 feet along the line of property of A. J. Smith to a stone in branch; thence down the branch N. 15° 10' 38" 848 feet to a bend; thence N. 18 E. 333 feet to a bend; thence N. 19° 30' W. 429 feet to a point in the intersection of said branch and Goldsby Creek; thence up Goldsby Creek S. 82° 45' feet 24.316 feet to a bend S. 36° 30' 21.393 feet to a bend; thence S. 32° 30' W. 405 feet to a bend; thence S. 56° 30' W. 380 feet to a bend; thence N. 86° 21.480 feet to a stake on said creek; thence S. 61° 15' 21.170 feet to a stake;
