INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Nine Hundred Thirteen and 74/100 (\$913.74) Dollars, to me paid by the said Harry Turner,the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said Harry Turner,

"All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, and State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lot No. 2 of the Overbrook Property, according to plat of Overbrook Land Company, recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "E" at page 251, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
