I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, Home Owners Loan Corporation,

on or about the 9th day of December in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and thirty-eight exhibited its complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against W. M. Babbs, Trustee of Estate of B. M. Babbs, William A. Alexander, et al.

demanding judgment in relation to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 11th day of February, 1939, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a Decree

NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars, to me paid by the said Home Owners Loan Corporation,

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said Home Owners Loan Corporation

"all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the improvements thereon, or to be erected thereon, situate lying and being on the southern side of Montgomery Avenue, near the city of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, in the State of South Carolina, being a portion of Lot No. 2, as shown on plat of property of Malinda O. Landrum made by William C. Hudson, Engineer, December 6, 1902, and recorded in Plat Book "A" at page 120; and bounded as follows: On the North by Montgomery Avenue, on the East by Lot now or formerly owned by J. H. Allen and R. L. Cruikshanks, on the South by property now or formerly owned by Joseph A.
