our Lord nineteen hundred and thirty-eight, exhibited her writ complaint in the Court  
Kingsbury, for the County aforesaid, against W. H. Moody, et al.

demanding judgment in relation to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 13th  
day of March, 1939, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a Decree

of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described be sold by E. INMAN, Master in and for the  
County aforesaid, on the terms and for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court will appear; and the Master, after having

dispose of the same unto D. A. Godfrey and Athaleen M. Godfrey

for the sum of Sixty Hundred eighty-five (\$685.00) Dollars,  
being at that price the highest bidder therefor.

NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of  
Sixty Hundred Eighty-five (\$685.00) Dollars,  
to me paid by the said,

D. A. Godfrey and Athaleen M. Godfrey,

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the  
said D. A. Godfrey and Athaleen M. Godfrey,

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land  
in Greenville County, in the State of South Carolina,  
as follows, to-wit:

In Greenville Township, near Monaghan Mill,  
about two miles west of Greenville Court-house,  
and being a portion of a subdivision known as  
City View, and having the following metes and  
bounds: Beginning at a stake on the corner of  
Summit Street and Hunt Street and running thence  
with Hunt Street N. 10 E. 100 feet to a stake, joint cor-  
ner lots 116 and 117; thence with the joint line of  
said lots in an easterly direction one hundred and  
twenty feet to a stake, joint corner of lots 116, 117,  
116a and 117a; thence in a southerly direction 100  
feet to a stake on Summit Street; thence with  
Summit Street 150 feet, more or less, to the beginning  
corner, being known and designated as lot Nos. 115  
and 116 as shown on plat of City View as recorded  
in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat  
Book A, page 1460-61, less that lot of land con-  
veyed by W. H. Moody and others to L. L. Phillips  
by deed dated May 15, 1934, and recorded in  
Deed Book 176, page 60."
