to me paid by K. O. Drace

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and release, unto the said K. O. Drace.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Black Springs Township Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the Town of Greer and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin at the northeast corner of Mrs. H. W. Drace's lot and runs thence with her line S. 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 200 feet to center of Arlington Avenue; thence with Arlington Avenue, S. 81 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 133 feet to an iron pin corner of the Berlin lot; thence about N. 4 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. with the center of a ditch on the Berlin line, 200 feet from center of Arlington Avenue to an iron spike in center of ditch N. M.; thence N. 83 W. 117 feet to the beginning iron pin, and contains 57 $\frac{1}{100}$  of an acre, more or less, and bounded by lands of Mrs. C. W. Drace, J. M. Miller and Planters Savings Bank and fronts on Arlington Avenue.
