All that piece or parcel of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, was the American Spinning Co. Village, being part of Lot No. 3 of the Hammett Lands on Hammett Street, according to plan, recorded in Deed Book H H at Page 835 and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning on the north side of Hammett Street at a pin, and running thence along Hammett Street S. 68 1/2 E. 62 feet to a corner; thence N. 21 E. 190 feet to an alley; thence along alley N. 68 1/2 W. 62 feet to a pin; thence S. 21 W. 190 feet to the beginning corner.
