All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about three miles West of Greenville County Court House, near the Easley Bridge Road, and being known and designated as Lot No. 50 of East Highland Subdivision, as shown by plat of same recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "C" at page 146, to which plat reference is made for metes and bounds. Said lot has a frontage of 80 feet on the West side of Virginia Avenue, with a depth of 215 feet.
