TITLE TO REALESTATE

STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA, COUNTY OF GREENVILLE.

KNOWN ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Poe Manufacturing Company, a corporation duly organized and incorporated under and by virtue of the laws of the State of South Carolina, for and in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other valuable considerations accruing to it, in hand paid by the Duke Power Company, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant unto the said Duke Power Company, its successors and assigns, the right, privilege a and easement to go in and upon that certain tract or lot of land situated in said County and State, near the City of Greenville, lying on both sides of the highway running from the City of Mill village, to the town of Travelers Rest, S. C., and known as the old Buncombe Road, and to construct and maintain in, upon and through said premises, in a proper manner, a line of poles on both sides of the said old Buncombe Road, from the point where said highway enters the property of the grantor herein, at or near D Street, adjoining section known as the "Ape Yard" and running thence in a Northerly direction along both sides of said highway through the property of the grantor; thence along both sides of A Street from the Buncombe Road to Hammett Street; thence along the Western side of said Hammett Street from A. Street to the Southeastern boundary line of the property of the grantor herein, and to construct and operate necessary wires, spans, trolleys, brackets, guy wires and other equipment, for the operation of trackless trolley coaches, and with permission to use grantor's streets herein designated for the operation of said trackles's trolley coaches; Provided no poles, wires and/or other obstruction be constructed and maintained in such a way as to interfere with grantor's use and enjoyment of its houses, buildings and power lines.

The grantor further grants the right, privilege and easement to grantee, itssuccessors and assigns, to use grantor's poles where convenient, and to attach necessary wires, guys, brackets and other equipment thereto, proper clearance between the wires of the grantor and the wires and equipment of the grantee to be maintained; and with the consent of the proper officers of the grantor to move at grantee's expense, poles of the grantor, so as to make them more accessible to and for the uses aforesaid of the grantee, its successors and assigns; Provided, in the event grantor's poles are pulled over or broken off as a result of the grantee's wires being attached thereto, the grantee, its successors and assigns will at its own expense replace said pole or poles, or otherwise remedy the trouble.

As a part consideration hereof, the grantor reserves the right to use at all times any pole or poles erected by the grantee, its successors and assigns, for the purpose of constructing and operating the grantor's power lines and wires, proper clearance between the wires of the grantor and the wires and equipment of the grantee to be maintained; in such case, however, the grantor will save harmless the grantee from any damage or liability which may arise from said use.

The grantee, its successors and assigns, by the acceptance of the rights, privilege and easement herein, agrees to indemnify and save harmless the grantor from all damage and liability accruing and/or to accrus to the grantor and arising and/or growing out of the negligent construction, maintenance and operation by the grantee, its agents and employee, or aforesaid poles, wires and equipment.
