Hopkins the then delinquent tax collector of the State and County aforesaid, did on the 21st. day of March, 1936, seize and take exclusive possession of the said property against which said taxes were assessed and levied, as hereinafter described, and on Sales Day of the month of May 1936, during the usual hours of sale, after due advertisement, sell the same to E. C. Honour and his heirs and assigns, the purchaser, hereinafter known as "grantee", and the highest bidder at such sale, for the sum of Seventeen and 47/100 dollars and gave a receipt for said purchase money to him

C. Honour, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, sell, bargain and release unto the said grantee, E. C. Honour, his heirs and assigns:
