## TITLE TO REALESTATE

STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA, COUNTY OF GREENVILLE.

THIS INDENTURE made and concluded at Greenville, South Carolina by and between Mrs. Annie O. Pike hereinafter referred to as the Landlord and C. R. Thompson hereinafter referred to as the Tenant, WITNESSETH:

That the Landlord for the rental hereinafter mentioned hereby rents and leases unto the tenant all that certain piece of land on the Buncombe Road in the County and State aforesaid containing 1.37 acres, more or less and more particularly described in the deed of I. W. Coleman to T. E. Pike December 15, 1927 and recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book, Vol. 130 at page 252, and the Tenant hereby agrees to pay as rent therefor the sum of Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars per annum payable in monthly payments of Twenty-Five (\$25.00) Dollars each commencing on the 23rd day of October, 1937 and this lease is to terminate on October 23, 1942.

It is further understood and agreed that the Landlord shall have the privilege of cutting stove wood on the s aid premises, but is not to cut the shade trees thereon during the continuance of this lease.

It is further understood and agreed that the Tenant shall have the privilege of making such improvements on the premises from time to time as he may see fit, the same to be done at his expense and upon the termination of this lease the improvements so made shall belong to the Landlord. Any personal property placed upon the premises by the Tenant may be removed by the Tenant at the expiration of this lease, It being distinctly understood that the improvements to be made by the Tenant as above provided shall be in the way of permanent improvements made to the buildings or the erection of other permanent improvements upon the premises.

The Tenant agrees to pay the rent hereinabove provided for and upon his failure to pay the rent promptly when due then this lease shall be terminated at the option of the Landlord, and the Landlord agrees that upon the Tenant paying the rent as hereinabove provided that he may peaceably hold and enjoy said premises for the term aforesaid. It being distinctly understood, however, that in case of the death of the Landlord that this lease will terminate on account of the fact that she only ownes a life estate in said property, And this lease is simply to bind her during her life time.
