KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Mrs. Roah Powell Page,

in the State aforesaid,
in consideration of the sum of
One dollar and love and affection for my son Louis Page. DOLLARS

to me in hand paid
at and before the sealing of these presents by

Louis Page.

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
Louis Page.

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the
State and County aforesaid, Oneal Township, about one mile east of the Double Springs Baptist
Church, on the South side of the road leading from Double Springs Church to Milford Church
adjoining lands of W. R. C. Edwards, T. B. Powell, and myself, and being lot number three of
the tract where I now live, and being a part of the same land conveyed to me by deed from T. B.
Powell on the first day of June, 1923, and recorded in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville
County in Deed Book 88 at page 351, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:-

Beginning on an iron pin in the center of the above mentioned road and on the line
of W. R. C. Edwards, and runs thence with the said road S. 86-00 W. 100 feet to an angle in road
and corner of tracts 1 and 2; thence continuing with the said road N. 88-35 W. 251 feet to an
iron pin in said road, corner of tract number one and on the T. B. Powell line; thence S. 7-10
E. 97 feet to an iron pin in pasture lane; thence S. 22-30 W. 562 feet to an iron pin on the bank
of creek; thence down the creek S. 56-30 E. 195 feet to a bend; thence S. 84-15 E. 220 feet to an
iron pin on the bank of the creek, W.R.C. Edwards corner; thence with the Edwards line N. 12-50
E. 766 feet to the beginning corner, and containing Six Acres, (6.00) more or less.

I hereby reserve unto myself a life estate in the above described property; and also
a life estate for my husband, J. B. Page, in case I should pre-decease him; however, if I pre-
decease my husband, and he should marry again, then this reservation in his favor shall become
null and void, and the title becomes absolute to Louis Page.

This deed is made subject to the reservations as shown in deed to me by J. B. Powell, said deed
bearing date of June 1st, 1923 and recorded in deed book 88 at page 351, in the office of the
R. M. C. for Greenville County.
