of Furman University made by Dalton & Neves, Registered Engineers, April, 1938, which plat is
recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book I, at page 99, the following
metes and bounds, to-wit:
Beginning at a Spanish Oak stump and line of other property of Furman University, and
running thence S. 29-30 E. 146.5 feet to a stake; thence S. 51-37 E. 120 feet to an iron pipe;
thence N. 64-23 E. 100 feet to an iron pin in the South bank of Reedy River; thence along the
center of Reedy River, the traverse line of which is N. 7-09 E. 320 feet to a point in the center
of the river; thence along the center of the River N. 5-45 W. 55 feet to a point in the center of
the river; thence still with the center of the river, N. 36-13 W. 129.5 feet to a point inthe
center of the river; thence still with the center of the river N. 60-26 W. 230 feet to a point in
