(passing a poplar) 511.5 feet to an iron pipe ('the southwest corner of Marshall Forest"); thence N. 64-50 E. 162.6; feet to an iron pin; thence N. 66-35 E. along the Pink James property about 1375 reet, more or less, to a corner of the lot this day conveyed by me to Mrs. Andrea C.
