TITLE TO REALESTATE

State of South Carolina, County of Greenville.

To All whom these presents may concern:

Whereas, R. N. Smith County Treasurer of said Greenville County, did issue his warrants directed to the Delinquent Tax Collector for said County and State by authority of the acts of the General Assembley of South Carolina and the statute laws of said State, against A. W. McDavid (Life Estate) defaulting taxpayer of said County, strictly charging and commanding said Delinquent Tax Collector of said County to levy by distress and sale of the lands of the said A. W. W. McDavid have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bell, bargain and release unto the said grantee, A. W. McDavid his heirs and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel and tract of land in Greenville County, South Carolina, about 14 miles south of the City of Greenville on the Augusta Road, in Oaklawn Township, known as the Andrew W. McDavid Home Place, being the same on which A. W. McDavid now resides, containing 260 acres, more or less, and being in School District No. 4-H of Greenville County."

Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

To Have and to hold all and singular the premises hereby granted, with the appurtenances, unto the said A. W. McDavid his heirs and assigns, forever, according to the form in force and effect of the laws and usages of the State of South Carolina in such cases made and provided.
