WHEREAS, thereafter, on December 26, 1934, said Lullwater Syndicate, Inc., by its proper officers executed and delivered a supplementary agreement ratifying and confirming the said agreement of November 5, 1934, which was agreement was thereto attached and made a part thereof, and said agreement of December 26, 1934, with the agreement of November 5, 1934, attached thereto and made a part thereof, was duly recorded on December 31, 1934, in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 178, at page 523, and

WHEREAS, Westboro Weaving Company has now made all payments in accordance with the terms of said contracts and is now entitled to conveyance in accordance therewith.

which reference is hereby made a s a part of this deed:

Parcel No. 1. That certain parcel or tract of land known as the Mill Site and shown on the map hereinabove referred to as Parcel #1, and having the following metes and bounds, as shown on said plat:

BEGINNING at a point on the south side of the right of way of C. & W. C. R. R., which point is 575 ft. from the center line of the old paving on Laurens Road as the same was located in October, 1934, (said paving having since been increased in width by addition to the north side thereof) and which point is 532.4 ft. measuring along the southern line of the right of way of C. & W. C. R. R. from a point in said line of the right of way and I foot north or northeast of the north of northeast line of the present sidewalk pavement of said Laurens Road; thence S. 18-0 E. 240 feet to an iron pipe; thence N. 72-0 E. 500 feet to an iron pipe; thence N. 18-0 W. 147.4 feet to an iron pipe on south side of the said right of way; thence in a westerly direction along the line of said right of way to the beginning corner, together with the appurtenances and any and all personal property located upon the above described parcel or tract of land and belonging to the grantor.
