W. E. Barnett, the following tract of land, to-wit:

Beginning at a point in the middle of the Greer-Brushy Creek road, (iron pin on South bank) same being corner of Fork Church lot, and running thence S. 7-15 W. 141 ft. to a stake; thence S. 12-30 E. 603 ft. to a point in center of Batesville-Brushy Creek road (stake on north bank); thence S. 54-40 E. 517.3 ft. to an angle in said road; thence S. 63.45 E. 182.7 ft. to an angle in said road; thence S. 74-00 E. 500 ft. to a point in said road, on W. E. James line; thence N. 25-45 W. 1135 ft. to a stake; thence N. 41-30 W. 617 ft. to a point in the center of the Greer-Brushy Creek road; thence S. 59-30 W. 210 ft. to an angle in said road; thence S. 61-15 W. 100 ft. to an angle in said road; thence S. 64-45 W. 115 ft. to the beginning corner, same being Tract No. 4 according to a plat made of the property of Mrs. Nanie Smith Estate, by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, August 1929, and containing 21.44 acres.
