Deed for Road.

Know all men by these presents, that I, Bessie Cantrell, wife of the late Mitchell Cantrell, in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar, to me in hand paid, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and for other valuable considerations, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the County of Greenville, its successors and assigns, a right-of-way as hereinafter described, on and over all lands which I may own in whole or in part.

It is the intention of the Deed to convey such parts, parcels or strips of land that may be needed to convey a right-of-way having the width of Forty (40) feet, that is Twenty (20) feet on each side of the center line, as staked out by the Engineer, except where there should be a cut or fill may be necessary for extra width.

This right-of-way begins on the north-west side of North Saluda River, near Engineer's station 7 plus 50, running along the line of Engineers stakes to the south-west side of the Talley Bridge Road, ending near Engineers station #14, being in length approximately 650 (Six hundred and fifty) Feet.

It is understood and agreed that any obstructions, such as pasture fences or gates, are to be relocated by Greenville County at points suggested by Owner; also, the County of Greenville is to put in convenient drive entrances at points suggested by the Owner. All of the above is to be at no expense whatever to the Owner.
