All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in Fairview Township, County and State aforesaid, containing 68 acres and known and designated as Tract No. 2 of the sub-division of the 492.9 acre tract of the Estate of E. B. Martin as shown by plat of same made by W. F. Adkins, Surveyor, February 26 - March 6, 1940, and according to said plat more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at stake in middle of Neely-Ferry Road at corner of Tract No. 1 shown on said sub-division and running thence along the middle of said road as the line N. 22-45 W. 18.67 chains to bend; thence still along the middle of said road N. 23-45 W. 3.00 chains to bend; thence still along the middle of said road N. 27-45 W. 6.40 chains to stake; thence N. 31 E. 4.29 chains to stake; thence S. 74-45 E. 15.95 chains to stake; thence S. 15-30 W. 10.85 chains to stake; thence S. 76 E. 11.35 chains to stake; thence S. 35 E. 18.43 chains to stake; thence S. 75-30 E. 16.25 chains to stake; thence S. 12 W. 6.15 chains to stake; thence N. 80 W. 21.43 chains to stake; thence N. 40 W. 13.00 chains to stake; thence S. 88 W. 10.00 chains to the point of beginning.

Said tract is bounded on the North by lands of B. W. Brooks; on the East by lands of R.H. Boyd; on the South by Tract No. 1 of said sub-division and on the West by Neely-Ferry road.

The within grantors and grantees are the sole heirs at law of E. B. Martin who died intestate July 27, 1938.
