TITLE TO REALESTATE

DEED

The State of South Carolina,

Know All Men By These Presents, that I, Mrs. A. E. Ramseur, a widow, of the City of Greenville, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars and other valuable considerations to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents, by A. Ramseur, of the City of Greenville, in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents, to grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said A. Ramseur:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, just outside the incorporate limits of the City of Greenville, on the Northern side of West Prentiss Avenue, being known as Lot No. 12, Block F, as shown on plat of property of O. P. Mills recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "C" at page 176, and a strip of 8 feet at the rear of said lot, being one-half $(\frac{1}{2})$ of a 16 foot alley which has heretofore been closed, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the North side of West Prentiss Avenue, 582 feet from the Northwest corner of Mission Street (formerly Church Street), corner of Lot No. 10, and running thence with the line of said Lot, N. 44-33 W. 188 feet to an iron pipe, corner of Lot No. 11, as extended; thence S. 45-27 W. 582 feet to an iron pipe on Mission Street; thence with the line of said Mission Street, S. 44-33 E. 188 feet to an iron pipe on West Prentiss Avenue; thence with the Northern side of West Prentiss Avenue, N. 45-27 E. 58 feet to the beginning corner; said premises being that conveyed to Mrs. A. Ramseur, a widow, the above named grantor, hereby expressly except and reserves from this grant a life estate in said lands, together with the possession, use, rents, profits and proceeds, thereof, unto myself for and during the term of my natural life, it being the intent of this conveyance to vest a present estate in fee simple in the grantee herein, subject to a life estate in the grantor.
