All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situated, lying and being in Greenville Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, just beyond the western limits of the City of Greenville, on the north side of the New Cut or Bramlett Road, as it is now called, known and designated as Lot Number Sixty Two (No. 62), as shown by Plat recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "A" at pages 68 and 69. Said lot has a frontage of Sixty (60) feet on the Bramlett Road and a depth in parallel lines of Two Hundred (200) feet. Said lot has a dwelling situated on it. This being the same lot of land conveyed to me by C. T. J. Giles by his deed dated Jan. 3, 1930, and recorded in Vol. 133 at page 203, said R. M. C. Office.
