the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said
Trustees of Rock Hill School and successors in office.

All that parcel, tract or lot of land, lying on the south side of the Old Spartanburg Road about five miles from the City of Greenville, being in Butler Township, County and state aforesaid, adjoining other lands of the grantor and also other lands of Rock Hill School, and having the following notes and bounds:-

Beginning on iron pin on the present School house line, thence N. 51 1/2 W. 2.26 chains to center of Spartanburg Hardsurface Road, thence with center of said road N. 61 3/4 E. 2.18 chains to a point in center of said road, thence S. 31 E. 4.42 chains to iron pin in pasture, thence S. 79 1/2 W. 3.62 chains to iron pin, thence N. 21 3/4 E. 2.34 chains to the beginning corner, and containing one acre more or less, according to survey made by J. Earle Freeman July 19, 1940.
