containing 94.25 acres, more or less, and being a portion of the 112 and one-fourth-acre tract of land conveyed to the grantor herein by C. G. Gunter, Inc., on May 1, 1941, deed to same recorded in Vol. 251, page 285, R. M. S. Office, County and State aforesaid, and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the branch on line of lands of C. G. Gunter, Inc., and formerly owned by Henry Smith and running thence with said line S. 59 E. 37.06 chains to a stone; thence S. 13-20 W. S. 70 chs. to a stone, thence S. 75 E. 24.88 chs. to a stone; thence N. 3/4 W. 1.50 to a R. O.; thence N. 31-20 E. S. 53 to a point on Brushy Creek; thence up said creek as the line to a stone, (corner of land now or formerly owned by Elcan Stread); thence along his line N. 33 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 15.20 chs. to a P. O.; thence N. 75 W. 26.30 to corner; thence N. 84 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 1.40 to a point on said Brushy Creek; thence along the creek as the line to a point in center of the bridge, corner of land of L. C.
