CHARTER

UKB AND CAMORPIPED OF RECE BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE.

WHEREAS,

MARION BRAWLEY, JR., AND J. M. PERRY, both of

GREENVILLE, S. C.,

did on the 6th day of April, 1946, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration, signed by themselves. setting fouth. signed by themselves, setting forth:

That their names and residences dreas above given. FIRST:

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is THE HAMER SPINNING

MILLS, INC.,

THIRD That the principal place of business is GREENVILLE, S. C. FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is

To orgage in and carry on the business of buying or otherwise acquiring, holding, owning, storing selling, bleaching, spinning, weaving, coning, throwing, manufacturing, dyeing, converting and chemically treating and o'herwise dealing in and with any and all kinds of woolen, worsted, silk, rayon, cotton, linen, jute, homp and other yarn, threads, and any and all other textile materials, products and by-products.

To act as textile manufacturers, jobbers and dealers in all of the branches of such businesses, to manufacture, own, purchase, sell and otherwise deal in and with textiles of every kind and description whether at wholesale or at retail.

To acquire by purchase, lease, exchange, hire, gift, devise or otherwise, lands or any interest therein; to erect and construct and operate buildings, factories, warehouses or works of every description on any land of the company, or upon any other land; to demolish, rebuild, enlarge, alter, repair and improve existing buildings, factories or works thereon; to convert, appropriate and dedicate any such land into and for roads, atreets, alleys, avenues and other conveniences; to buy, sell, lease, let, mortgage, farm, improve and otherwise dispose of, industrial machinery and equipment, and manage the lands, buildings, and other property of the company; to undertake or direct the management and sale of real property, buildings and lands and to buy and hold real estate of every description for investment or otherwise.

To manufacture, purchase, or otherwise acquire, own, mortgage, pledge, sell, assign and transfer, or otherwise dispose of, to invest, trade, deal in and deal with, goods, wares and merchandise and personal property of every class and description.

To acquire, and pay for in cash, stock or bonds of this corporation or otherwise, the good will, rights, assets and property, and to undertake or assume the whole or any part of the obligations or liabilities of any person, form, association or corporation.

To acquire, hold, use, sell, assign, lease, grant licenses in respect of, mortgage, or otherwise dispose of letters patent of the United States or any forlign country, patent rights, licenses and privileges, inventions, improvements and processes, copyrights, trademarks and trade names relating to or useful in connection with any business of this comporation.

To purchase, hold, roll, assign, transfer, mortgage, pledge or otherwise dispose of shares of the capital stock of, or any bonds, securities or evidences of indebtedness created by any other corporation or corporation or corporations organized under the laws of this state or any other state, country, nation or government, and while the owner thereof to exercise all the rights, powers and privileges of ownership, including the right to vote.

To onter into, make and perform contracts of every kind and description with any person, firm, association, corporation, municipality, county, state, body politic or government or colony or dependency thereof.

To borrow money for the purpose of carrying out the objects of the corporation and from time to time, without limit as to amount, to make, accept, enderse and issue promissory notes, bonds and other evidences of debt and to secure the payment of any of its obligations by mortgage or deed in trust on all or any of its property and franchises, both real and personal.

To have one or more offices, to carry on all or any of its operations and business and without restriction or limit as to amount to purchase or otherwise acquire, hold, own, mortgage, sell, convey, or otherwise dispose of real and personal property of every class and description in South Carolina and any of the States, Districts, Territories or colonies of the United States, and in any and all foreign countries, subject to the laws of such State, Distriot, Territory, Solony or Country.

In general, to carry on any other business in connection with the foregoing, whether manufacturing or otherwise, and to have and exercise all the powers conferred by the laws or South Carolina upon corporations formed under the act hereinafter referred to, and to do any or all of the things hereinbefore set forth to the same extent as natural persons might or could do.
