situate, lying and being on the East side of Rutherford Road and the South side of South Woodside Circle, and being known and designated as Lots Nos. 9, 10, 11 and 12 of Woodside Circle, Plat of which is recorded in Plat Book E, page 219, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, reference to which is craved for a more particular description. Said lots have an aggregate frontage of 100 feet on said Rutherford Road, with a depth of 150 feet.

My father L. H. Cary, now deceased, owned an undivided one-half interest in the above described property, and willed same to my mother Fannie S. Cary, and it was my understanding that my mother had the right and power to sell and convey good title to the interest which my father had, but some question has been raised with reference to whether the children of L.
