

TITLE TO REAL ESTATE

Lillie G. Ballentine, her heirs and assigns:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point at the junction of Clairemont Drive and Lake Drive and runs thence N. 18.30 E. 375 feet; thence N. 73.19 W. along Lake Drive 61.7 feet; thence N. 45.19 W. 184.4 feet; thence N. 31.34 W. 330.1 feet; thence N. 84.04 W. 52.4 feet; thence S. 55.36 W. 178 feet; thence N. 77.39 W. 174 feet; thence S. 31.47 W. 85.8 feet; thence S. 37.55 E. 66.4 feet; thence S. 59.25 E. 280.5 feet along Lake Drive; thence S. 31.25 E. 376.2 feet; thence S. 57.55 E. 246.3 feet to the beginning corner, the same being designated as the Lake as shown by plat of Piney Mountain Land Company.
