TITLE TO REAL ESTATE

- 8. All sewage disposal shall be by septic tank, meeting the approval of the State Board of Health, until such time as municipal sewerage is made abailable.
- 9. These covenants are to run with the land as a part of the general plan of development and shall be binding on all the parties hereto, their heirs and assigns, and all persons claiming under then until January 1, 1966.
- violate or attempt to violate any of the covenants herein it shall be lawful for any other person or persons owning any real property situated in said development or subdivision to prosecute any proceedings at law or in equity against the person or persons violating or attempting to violate any such covenant and either to prevent him or them from so doing or to recover damages or other dues for such violation.

ll. Invalidation of any one of these covenants by judgment or court order shall in no wise affect any of the other provisions which shall remain in full force and effect.
