## TITLE TO REAL ESTATE

STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA:

THIS MUTUAL CONVEYANCE, Made and executed this the 13th day of November, 1941, by and between DUKE POWER COMPANY, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of New Jersey, party of the first part, hereinafter called the "Power Company", and THE FLORENCE MILIS, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of South Carolina, party of the second part, hereinafter called the "Mills", WITNESSETH;

That for and in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements herein contained, the parties hereto have contracted and do contract with each other as follows:

- The Power Company will, within a reasonable time from the date hereof, remove its power lines now located upon the property of the Mills, at or near the City of Greenville, S. C., which lines are indicated in green upon the print dated October 22, 1941, marked "Exhibit A", here to attached and made a part hereof, and upon the removal of said lines the right of way occupied by said lines shall revert to and become the property of the Mills free and clear of any right on the part of the Power Company to occupy same as a right of way.
- 2. The Power Company does hereby quitclaim and release to the Mills, its successors and assigns, the Power line and right of way occupied by same shown in red upon the print dated October 22, 1941, marked "Exhibit B", hereto attached and made a part hereof.
- 3. The conveyance and release of the rights of way hereinabove set out shall not be construed to interfere with or affect the right of way of the Power Company for its 100 KV line shown on said prints, nor with the right of way for the "Camp Sevier 13 KV Line" shown on said
- 4. The Mills hereby grants and conveys to the Power Company, its successors and assigns, the right, privilege and easement to go in and upon the premises of the Mills, at or near the City of Greenville, S. C., indicated on the print Exhibit A hereto attached, and to construct, maintain and operate in, upon and through said premises in a proper manner, with poles, wires and other necessary apparatus and appliances, a line for the purpose of transmitting power by electricity, together with the right at all times to enter said premises for the purpose of inspecting said line and making necessary repairs and alterations thereon, together with the right at all times to cut away and keep clear of said line all trees and other obstructions that may in any way endanger the proper maintenance and operation of the same; said line shall extend from the 2-pole bent of the Power Company in a southwesterly and southerly direction to Pole No. 5, all as is shown in red indicated "Proposed Relocation 13 KV Line" on said print marked "Exhibit A".
