(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said J. A. Green, his Heirs and assigns, forever:-
All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land in the County of Greenville, State of South
Carolina, containing 101.30 acres, more or less, as shown on a plat of property divided for J. A.
Green and W. B. Traynham, made by W. J. Riddle, April 14, 1941, recorded in Book L, page 145, public records of Greenville County, South Carolina, and having according to said plat, the following metes
and bounds, to-wit:
Beginning at an iron pin at the corner of property of the Henry Williams Estate, and running
thence with said Estate line North 41 degrees West 808 feet to an iron pin; thence North 70 degrees
12 minutes West 86.4 feet to an iron pin; thence North 53 degrees 42 minutes West 203 feet, crossing
