HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these Presents, DO GRANT, convey, and release unto the said __William T. Moore and Nancy Gertrude Moore.

"All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land lying and being situate in the Town of Simpson ville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and shown by courses and distances and metes and_bounds,_as_follows._to-wit:_
